Acacia salicina	Cooba	4-10m T	Local species, pendulous green foliage, pale yellow flowers, most soils.
Acacia stenophylla	River Cooba	4-10m T	Local species, erect weeping small tree, pale yellow flowers, most soils.

Agonis flexuosa	Willow Myrtle	6-10m T, A	Medium tree, weeping habit, clusters of white flowers spring.

Banksia integrifolia	Coast Banksia	4-7m T P	Medium tree, yellow flower spikes summer-autumn.

Brachygyton

Brachygyton acerifolius	Illawarra Flame Tree	5-10m A	Medium tree, partly deciduous late spring, red flowers during early summer.
Brachygyton australis	Broad-leaved Bottle Tree	5-8m P A	Deciduous tree, cream-white flowers spring.
Brachygyton populneus	Kurrajong	5-10m T A	Local species, dense crowned tree, small cream-white bell shaped flowers, most soils.
Brachygyton discolor	Lacebark	8-16m A	Spreading deciduous tree, pink flowers late spring-early summer, suitable most soils.
Brachygyton rupestris	Queensland Bottle Tree	8m P A	Semi-deciduous tree, small white flowers, suitable most soils.

Eucalyptus albopurpurea	Port Lincoln Gum	4-6m T	Small branched mallee, green foliage, purple-pink-mauve flowers, suitable most soils.
Eucalyptus caesia ssp magna	Silver Princess	8m T, A	Highly ornamental, pendent habit, silver-grey leaves, fruit, and young stems, with large red-pink flowers
Eucalyptus camaldulensis (subcinerea)	Silverton Gum	12m T	Large erect tree, white flowers, suitable most soils.
Eucalyptus erythrocorys	Illyarie	8m T	Small tree, large green leaves, bright yellow flowers with red caps, most soils.
Eucalyptus kingsmillii	Kingmillii's Mallee	5-6 m P	Small mallee with compact habit, large pink flowers, well drained soils.
Eucalyptus largiflorens	Black Box	15-20m T	Local species, large tree, small white and at times pink flowers, wet conditions.
Eucalyptus leucoxyloides ssp megalocarpa	Red-flowered Yellow Gum	6-8m T	Small tree, profuse pink-red flowers in April-July. Most soils.
Eucalyptus meliodora	Yellow Box	20-35m T	Local species, large tree, white flowers, drooping foliage, most well drained soils.
Eucalyptus microcarpa	Grey Box	15-25m T	Local species, large tree, rough grey bark, small white flowers, most soils
Eucalyptus nicholii	Willow Peppermint	8-12m T, A	Medium erect tree, willowy foliage, white flowers, most soils
Eucalyptus petiolaris		6-8m T	Small tree, profuse red-pink flowers during autumn - winter, most soils
Eucalyptus populnea	Bimble Box	10-15m T	Local species, medium tree, small white flowers, most soils.
Eucalyptus robusta	Swamp Mahogany	10m T	Medium tree, dark green leaves, white flowers, most soils, damp conditions.
Eucalyptus salignia	Sydney Blue Gum	30-40m T, A	Tall tree, white smooth bark, white flowers, most soils.

Eucalyptus sideroxylon rosea	Mugga Ironbark	10-15m T, A	Medium tree, grey to black bark, grey-blue foliage, flowers pink, moist soils.
Eucalyptus stricklandii	Stricklandi's Gum	6-8m T	Small tree, clusters of yellow flowers in summer, most soils.
Eucalyptus torquata	Coral Gum	5-7m T	Small tree, rough grey bark, red-pink flowers any time of the year, most soils.
Eucalyptus viridis	Green Mallee	5-7m T	Local species, hardy slender mallee, dark green narrow leaves, white flowers, most soils.
Eucalyptus woodwardii	Lemon-flowered Gum	8-10m T, A	Ornamental medium upright growing tree, drooping grey-blue foliage, profuse yellow flowers during July -September, most soils.
Eucalyptus albens	White Box	16m T	Medium upright tree, light grey bark, leaves silvery grey, white-cream flowers summer - winter.
Eucalyptus hybrid	Torwood	6-8m T P A	Small to medium tree, very floriferous, salmon pink flowers; September - October.
Eucalyptus victrix	Little Ghost Gum	3 - 8m T, P	Ornamental small to medium open tree, smooth white bark, white - cream flowers in summer.
Eucalyptus salmonophloia	Salmon Gum	18 - 20m T	Fast growing large open tree, smooth salmon coloured bark, small cream flowers.
Eucalyptus saxatilis	Suggan Buggan Mallee	5 - 8m P	Attractive multi-stemmed mallee, smooth grey green bark and bluish green leaves, with cream flowers.
Eucalyptus blakelyi	Blakely's red gum	18m T	Local species. Large upright tree, flowers white.
Eucalyptus elata	River Peppermint	12 - 18m T	Erect medium tree, drooping branches, smooth white bark upper branches, grey rough barked trunk, white flowers.
Eucalyptus gardneri	Blue Mallet	6-9m T	Small erect tree, blue-green foliage, smooth pale brown bark, pale yellow flowers winter.
Eucalyptus polyanthemus	Red Box	12m T	Medium sized tree, light brown-grey bark, ovate to oval blue - grey leaves, white flowers spring - summer.

Lophostemon confertus	Brush Box	6-9m T A	Medium tree, dense crown habit, dark green leaves, white flowers spring.

Melaleuca linariifolia	Snow in Summer	6-10m T	Small tree, white flowers, late spring-summer.
Melaleuca styphelioides	Prickly Paperbark	6-8m T	Small erect tree/shrub, cream/white flowers, late spring - early summer
Melaleuca fulgens	Apricot flower form	1.5m P	Rounded shrub, narrow leaves, apricot flowers in spring - summer.
Melaleuca micromera		2.5m P	Rounded shrub, attractive foliage, small heads of yellow flowers spring - summer.

Corymbia eximia	Yellow Bloodwood	8-10m T A	Medium tree, flaky yellow-brown bark, leaves green, white flowers, most soils.
Corymbia ficifolia	WA Flowering Gum	7-10m T, A	Medium tree, large red-orange-pink flowers December - January, most soils.
Corymbia ficifolia	Flame Red (grafted)	4-6m A	Grafted tree, masses large red flowers December - January cultivars
Corymbia maculata	Spotted Gum	30-45m T, A	Large tree, smooth mottled grey bark, white flowers, most soils.
Corymbia citriodora	Lemon-scented Gum	25-30m T A	Large attractive tree, white flowers spring, smooth white - pale grey bark, aromatic lemon-scented leaves.
Corymbia eximia nana	Dwarf Yellow Bloodwood	6-8m	Compact small to medium tree, masses of large showy white flowers spring.
